



Looking Back at the Beginning



Mary Schadenberg (now Fraser) was attending the 1970 National Catholic Women's League Conference in Toronto, when Louise Summerhill took the podium and delivered a passionate speech about Pierre Trudeau's 1969 Omnibus Bill decriminalizing abortion and how Christians must reach out to women contemplating abortion. Summerhill had helped found Birthright for this very reason.

Inspired by the story and appalled that children were being aborted in Canada, Mary returned home to Woodstock where she and her husband, Harry Schadenberg, arranged for Dr. Barry Deveber, a pro-life speaker, to come speak about abortion's spread to Canada. Despite a raging snowstorm, one hundred people attended this open meeting one night in February 1971 and many signed up.

The group opened an office, Birthright Woodstock, to counsel and support pregnant girls to have their babies. The schools were calling for a speaker. Dr. Deveber provided Mary with a set of slides and a handbook on abortion. She went on to speak in local schools, at debates and women's groups.

In March 1975, Right to Life Woodstock was formed and on April 9th, 1975 at the WCI Auditorium, hosted a panel of experts on abortion comprised of a doctor, a lawyer and a teacher. Two hundred people attended and signed the Petition of One Million which was presented in the House of Commons in May 1975. The public accepted our organization with high regard. We spoke on Rogers Television, Tillsonburg Radio, as well as in the schools, and letters to the editor which we wrote were printed in the Woodstock Sentinel-Review. (continued on page 2)

In 1991, Woodstock Right to Life became incorporated as Oxford County Right to Life to better reflect the extent of its membership and the area it served. Since 1991, Woodstock Beginnings (now Dayspring) has taken over the practical counselling and supporting of women with an unplanned pregnancy to bring their baby to term. Oxford County Right to Life remains an educational pro-life organization that promotes respect for human life from conception to natural death.

50th Anniversary Dinner



On June 20, 2025, Tamara Jansen (MP - Cloverdale - Langley City) introduced private members Bill C-218 in the House of Commons to prevent euthanasia (MAiD) for mental illness by excluding mental illness from being considered a "grievous and irremediable medical condition" for the purposes of MAiD.

If passed, no one will be eligible for MAiD for mental illness alone. Bill C-218 will likely receive its first hour of debate in November 2025.

Petition Opposing Ontario Bill 4

<u>Bill 4</u> was introduced by Ontario NDP MLA France Gélinas on April 16, 2025. It has not yet been debated in the Ontario legislature.

Bill 4 would change *The Gift of Life Act* (Ontario), which requires consent to obtain organs and tissues, and replaces it with presumed consent. The Ontario government would consider you to be an organ donor unless you have stated otherwise.



Bill 4 also changes the *Connecting Care Act 2019* for the planning, co-ordinating, undertaking, supporting and promoting of activities relating to the removal, donation and use of human tissue, including the co-ordinating and supporting of designated facilities in connection with the removal and use of human tissue for transplant.
